Dr. Nishan Wijetunge holds a Bachelor's degree and a Master's degree in Architecture from University of Moratuwa, Sri Lanka, a Masters in Architecture & Interior Design from London metropolitan University, U.K. and a PhD in Architecture from Nottingham Trent University, U.K. He also has a Postgraduate Diploma in Research Practice from Nottingham Trent University, U.K. He specializes in architectural history and culture.

Dr. Nishan Wijetunge is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Design & Merchandising, at Oklahoma State University, USA since 2023. Previously, he has also served as an Associate Professor in the Department of Architecture at the Southern Campus of General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University (KDU), Sri Lanka from 2022-2023. Prior to that, he has been a Senior Lecturer at the Department of Architecture at

University of Moratuwa, Sri Lanka from 2014-17. He has also served as a visiting lecturer at a number of institutions; KDU, Sri Lanka (2018-22), City School of Architecture (2014-22), Sri Lanka, and Nottingham Trent University, U.K. (2010-11). He has been an Hon. Research Fellow at University of Liverpool, U.K. (2017-18).

He is a Fellow Member of the Sri Lanka Institute of Architects (SLIA) since 2020, and is also an International Member of the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) since 2021. Between 2020-21, he served as an elected Council Member of the SLIA, and as the Secretary of the SLIA Board of Architectural Publications (BAP).

Nishan has had a 13-years old Colombo-based Architectural practice named 'Modulus2 Architects' which has provided full architectural services for more than 250 architecture and interior design projects in Sri Lanka. His projects have appeared in around thirty TV programs, as well as over fifty magazines/newspapers or web platforms promoting architecture as an art, to the public.

For his outstanding performances as a researcher, he received a Gold Medal at the Sri Lanka Institute of Architects Publications Awards, and a Silver Medal at the Sri Lanka Institute of Architects Research Award in 2017.

His academic excellence manifests via his prolific publications in peer-reviewed journals, books, magazines, newspapers, newsletters and web articles etc. as well as research awards, architectural exhibitions and films. He has served as the editor-in-chief of two peer-reviewed international academic journals: *KDU Journal of Built Environment (KDU-JBE)* (2023-24) and the *Built-Environment Sri Lanka (BE-SL)* (2019-20).
