

Quality Standards of the ISVS e-journal

1. Publication Fee

Publication of a quality journal and keeping it afloat in the internet costs and this cost has to be shared by the authors. This is because, it is open access and does not charge any fees for the use of the papers published. It has therefore a Publication Fee of 300 USD payable only after the paper has been accepted for publication, pursuant to review and revisions.

Quality is at the heart of the ISVS e-journal. Acting with integrity and transparency, we seek to build partnerships with authors, editors and readers alike. As such, this journal will never:

- Ask authors to pay a submission fee.
- Ask authors to pay an APC (article processing charge) for publication prior to acceptance.
- Publish works in exchange for gifts or money.
- Falsely claim to represent another person or entity.
- Use your data without consent.

2. Adherence to Standards

This journal will:

- Ensure your published paper is peer reviewed by two reviewers, and constructive and advisory feedback and criticism will be provided.
- Ensure accepted works are published, hosted and made discoverable via the Journal website.
- Assign DOIs to accepted work and preserve the published versions.
- Act in accordance with the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) in dealing with matters of ethical misconduct

3. Quality of Language

Use of inclusive language

We request all authors to choose language that is inclusive and respectful. Submissions should not contain anything that might imply that one individual is superior to another on the grounds of race, gender, culture, sexuality, or any other characteristic, and inclusive language should be used throughout. Authors should ensure that writing is free from bias, for instance by using 'he or she', 'his or hers', 'him or her', or the singular gender-neutral 'they, theirs or them'.

Please also ensure that your language is grammatically correct, uses appropriate research terminology and is aimed at effective communication of research findings to the scientific community. If you lack the skills to write well in the English language, you may seek professional help from an English fluent person or a service, prior to submission or during the period of revision. In any case, the Journal will not publish papers written poor language.
