

Thank you for sending the revised paper. However, we have discovered that there are numerous issues that need to be resolved and therefore it needs further revisions. Although it is earmarked to be published in the Vol. 13 Issue 3, it can be published only if the revisions are done well. Herewith I am sending you another review done using 'track change,' comments. It also suggests language corrections sentence by sentence and word by word. Three major issues exist.

1. Its theoretical framework cites only Rapoport (1969). This is not acceptable. There are many other significant theoreticians such as Oliver, Alsayed and Susan Denyer whose theoretical articulations must be discussed. Moreover, it was noted that the citations were done wrong mentioning names of books, which should be avoided. One book ascribed to Rapoport is not by him. These are major faults.
2. There is no proper review of literature. What is written is an extension to the theoretical framework, which implies that the difference between the two is not understood. A proper review of literature is needed.
3. Serious language issues also exist: they involve grammar issues as well as improper use of definite and indefinite articles. Corrections have been suggested. Please revise accordingly and send me a final revised version addressing all these issues. I look forward to hearing from you,
